Wills and Living Trusts

Think you might not have much of an estate? Think again! After adding up the value of one's home equity, retirement accounts, and life insurance policies, many come to realize their estate is worth much more than they originally thought. *Entrusting the University Catholic Center with a gift from your estate is one of the easiest and most effective ways in which to support our campus ministry at the University of Texas!*

Please consider including the University Catholic Center in your Will or Living Trust. A planned gift to the UCC ensures that your legacy will live on after your lifetime, and will continue to provide for, and positively impact, the future leaders of our Church.

If you do choose to make an estate gift to the UCC, please make sure such a request/gift is clearly stated in your will or living trust. We encourage the following bequest language:

Retirement Accounts, Life Insurance & Investments

Who have you listed as the primary or contingent (secondary) beneficiary of your retirement accounts or life insurance? Did you know all life insurance, investment, and retirement assets left to the UCC will be tax-free because we are a certified tax-exempt 501(c)(3) non-profit organization?

Take a look at your 401(k), 403(b), IRA, Annuities or Life Insurance policy. **If you have not listed a primary and a contingent beneficiary, please prayerfully consider designating the University Catholic Center as such.** The beneficiaries listed can be easily modified at any time, to meet your changing needs over the course of your life. For workplace accounts, your HR department can easily help make changes to your beneficiary designations. For private accounts, like IRAs, contact the investment company to request a beneficiary designation form. Often, you can do all of this online!

We encourage the following language:

“I designate the University Catholic Center at the University of Texas to receive the sum of [\$ ____ or ____ % of my account/policy].”
